





A Robotics workshop is a hands-on learning experience that focuses on teaching participants how to use of various process automation tools and technology in robotics. The workshop typically involves a combination of lectures, demonstrations, and practical exercises that are designed to give participants a comprehensive understanding of robotics.

The workshop typically starts with an introduction to **STEMROBO TECHNOLOGY** and the different types of robots that exist, such as mobile robots, industrial robots, and humanoid robots. Participants may then learn about the various components that make up a robot, such as sensors, actuators, and microcontrollers. By using tools to analyse the process and check whether they can be automated .it does not require any programming skills to configure the software robot. since it is a code free technology any non-technical person can set up the bot using drag and drop features.it is also includes the 'recorder' to record the steps of automation.

After the initial introduction, participants usually have the opportunity to instructed to use a tool like a sensor automatically light on/off LDR or a set of components and LED light on/off sensor. They will be given instructions on how to perform a specific task, such as the difference between micro bit & Arduino that is: the micro: bit generally has more processing power and memory than the Arduino. The main reason you might choose the micro: bit is that its LED display can act as a visual screen in itself and you can interact with it with the buttons on either side.

Throughout the workshop, participants are encouraged to work in teams and share ideas and strategies. They will also have the opportunity to ask questions and receive feedback from the workshop instructors.

By the end, participants will have gained and understanding of robotics and the skills needed to uses of tools or set of components in robotic, how to access to learn stemrobo. 





Then all these cadets took an oath to serve the school and its principles.









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#### ORIENTATION PROGRAM FOR TEACHERS

Oxford University Press organised an orientation programme on "INNOVATION IN MATHEMATICS TEACHING" for foundational and preparatory stages was held on 11<sup>th</sup> Nov2022 at best western ashoka at lakdikapul.

The resource person of the workshop was Miss. Ashalata Badami a well known Mathematics expert and an authoe of Oxford University Press. This workshop was attended by many teachers from different schools.

Ms. Ashalata Badani emphasized on those concepts which were difficult for the students to understand in their primary level. She introduced innovative methods which can be used in the class to make the students enjoy the concepts and make the class lively.

For example, she explained how the operations of Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division can be easily understood if they are taught using place values blocks. Also, the concept of factors and multiples can be easily using the colour patterns in the number grid 1 to 100.

We found this workshop very interesting and stimulating as it focused mainly on the concept building and how to engage the students through activity based method. We learnt a nmber of techniques in making mathematics a joyful learning for the students.


